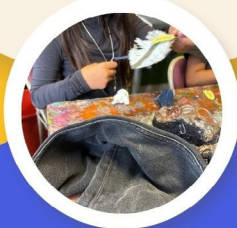

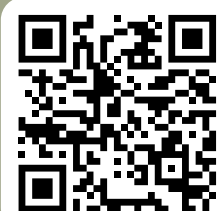
Surbiton & Tolworth
