WINTER 2023

Work starts to demolish the Tadlow building in Phase 1. Queen Mary Hall opens in Cambridge Gardens - The temporary community centre replaces Piper Hall until the new community centre for the Cambridge Road Estate is completed

in phase 1 of the regeneration programme.

Piper Hall closes. Hoarding is extended to include Piper Hall and Ely Court/Franklin Close.
